2 (a) Except as provided in § 8-305(c) of this subtitle, AND EXCEPT FOR

3 SECURITY PERSONNEL IN CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES WHO WORK AN ALTERNATE

4 WORK SCHEDULE AS PROVIDED IN § 8-305(D) OF THIS SUBTITLE, a law enforcement

5 employee of any unit of State government or a State Police cadet who works more

6 than 8 hours in a normal 8-hour workday is entitled to be paid at the rate of one and 7 one-half times the employee's or cadet's regular hourly rate of pay for time worked in

8 excess of 8 hours.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 9 10 effect October 1, 2004.
