- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Article 83A - Department of Business and Economic Development

- 16 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, in exercising its corporate
- 17 powers, the Corporation is exempt from the provisions of Articles 41 and 78A of the
- 18 Code; § 10-507 of the State Government Article; and Title 2, Subtitles 2, 4, and 5,
- 19 Titles 3 and 4, Title 6, Subtitle 1, Title 7, Subtitles 1, 2, and 3, §§ 8-127, 8-128, and
- 20 8-129, Part V of Title 8, Subtitle 1, and Title 10[, and Division II] of the State
- 21 Finance and Procurement Article, and may carry out its corporate purposes without
- 22 obtaining the consent of any department, board, or agency of the State.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2004.
