2 Washington County - Deputy Clerk or Sheriff - Oath of Office

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that every deputy clerk or sheriff in Washington County
- 4 take and sign the oath or affirmation prescribed by the Maryland Constitution;
- 5 and generally relating to oaths of office.
- 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 7 Article Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 14 2-104.
- 15 (a) Every auditor, clerk, sheriff, constable, commissioner, surveyor, or other
- 16 officer before he assumes the duties of his office, shall take and sign the oath or
- 17 affirmation prescribed by the Constitution.
- 18 (b) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, every deputy clerk or
- 19 sheriff shall take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation: "I, A.B., do swear
- 20 (or affirm) that I will not for lucre or malice delay any person applying to me for any
- 21 business belonging to the office I officiate in, and that I will not directly or indirectly
- 22 ask, take, exact, demand, or receive from or charge to any such person to my own use
- 23 any fee or reward whatsoever for any services I may do as deputy of the said office,
- 24 and that in making out the office fees I will not wittingly or willingly charge other or
- 25 higher fees than are allowed by law."
- 26 (c) (1) In addition to the oath or affirmation required under subsection (b) of
- 27 this section, in St. Mary's County, every deputy sheriff shall take and subscribe the
- 28 following oath or affirmation: "I, A.B., do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will bear

- 1 true faith and allegiance to the United States of America and to the State of
- 2 Maryland; that I will serve honestly and faithfully to uphold and defend the
- 3 Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of Maryland; that I will
- 4 enforce the laws of St. Mary's County, and the State of Maryland; and that I will obey
- 5 the orders of the Sheriff and of my superior officers according to the rules and
- 6 regulations of the Sheriff's office, St. Mary's County and the State of Maryland."
- 7 (2) In addition to the oath or affirmation required under subsection (b) of
- 8 this section, in Charles County, every deputy sheriff shall take and subscribe the
- 9 following oath or affirmation: "I, A.B., do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will bear
- 10 true faith and allegiance to the United States of America and to the State of
- 11 Maryland; that I will serve honestly and faithfully to uphold and defend the
- 12 Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of Maryland; that I will
- 13 enforce the laws of Charles County, and the State of Maryland; and that I will obey
- 14 the orders of the Sheriff and of my superior officers according to the rules and
- 15 regulations of the Sheriff's office, Charles County and the State of Maryland."
- 16 (d) In Montgomery County AND WASHINGTON COUNTY, every deputy clerk or
- 17 sheriff shall take and sign the oath or affirmation prescribed by Article I, § 9 of the
- 18 Maryland Constitution.
- 19 (e) (1) Except as authorized by Article I, § 10 of the Constitution, every
- 20 officer, except the clerk of the circuit court of a county or an appellate court, shall take
- 21 the oath before the clerk of the circuit court.
- 22 (2) Except as provided in Article I, § 10 of the Constitution, the clerk of a
- 23 circuit court shall take the oath before a judge of the court.
- 24 (3) The clerk of an appellate court shall take the oath before the
- 25 Governor.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 2004.
