- 22 CareFirst BlueCross BlueShield, the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland,
- 23 and licensed or certified providers of treatment for a mental illness, emotional
- 24 disorder, or a drug abuse or alcohol abuse disorder, shall adopt regulations to
- 25 implement the provisions of this subtitle.
