25	(b) (1) (i) Subject to subsection (a) of this section, a special Class C beer license or a special Class C beer and wine license entitles the holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by the respective classes of licenses for the use of any person holding any hone fide anterteinment conducted by any club, acciety or association at

26 holding any bona fide entertainment conducted by any club, society or association at27 the place described in the license, for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days

28 from the effective date thereof.
