BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 19 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 20 7-101. 21 A special Class C beer, wine and liquor license entitles the (d) (1) 22 holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by this class of license for the use of 23 any person holding a bona fide entertainment conducted by a club, society, or 24 association at the place described for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days, 25 upon the payment of a fee of \$15 per day. (10)Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection, in Montgomery 26 27 County:

- 1 (i) The fee is [\$30] \$60 per day; and
- 2 (ii) Notwithstanding § 1-102(a)(4) of this article, the Board of 3 License Commissioners may issue a one-day special Class C beer, wine and liquor 4 license to a community swimming pool club.
