1 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages** 2 7-101. 3 (d) (1) (i) A special Class C beer, wine and liquor license entitles the 4 holder to exercise any of the privileges conferred by this class of license for the use of 5 any person holding a bona fide entertainment conducted by a club, society, or 6 association at the place described for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days, 7 upon the payment of a fee of \$15 per day. 8 (10)Notwithstanding paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection, in Montgomery 9 County: 10 (i) The fee is [\$30] \$60 per day; and 11 (ii) Notwithstanding § 1-102(a)(4) of this article, the Board of 12 License Commissioners may issue a one-day special Class C beer, wine and liquor 13 license to a community swimming pool club. 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
