

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages** 18 12-107. 19 It shall be unlawful for any person to drink on the licensed premises 20 of any license holder any alcoholic beverages not purchased from the license holder on 21 said premises and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the premises; and 22 it shall be unlawful for any license holder to permit any person to drink any alcoholic 23 beverage not purchased from the said license holder on the premises covered by the 24 license which he holds and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the 25 premises.

This subsection does not apply to special or temporary licenses in
