- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN,
- 20 CONTRACT, OR POLICY ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THIS STATE THAT COVERS
- 21 INDIVIDUALS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS.
- 22 (B) AN INSURER MAY EXCLUDE COVERAGE FOR A MANDATED HEALTH
- 23 BENEFIT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IF:
- 24 (1) THE BENEFIT RELATES TO A CONDITION REVEALED DURING
- 25 MEDICAL UNDERWRITING; AND
- 26 (2) THE BENEFIT RELATED TO THE CONDITION IS EXCLUDED BY A
- 27 WAIVER RIDER THAT IS SIGNED BY THE INSURED AND ATTACHED TO THE CONTRACT.
