2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages Violations - Maximum Fine**
3 **PG 301-04**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the maximum fine that the Prince George's County
5 Board of License Commissioners may impose for certain alcoholic beverages
6 violations instead of or in addition to certain other penalties; and generally
7 relating to penalties for alcoholic beverages violations in Prince George's County.

9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 16-507.

17 (r) In Prince George's County the Board of License Commissioners may
18 impose a fine not exceeding [\$12,500] \$7,000 instead of or in addition to suspension or
19 revocation of a license for any violation that is cause for suspension or revocation
20 under the alcoholic beverage laws affecting Prince George's County.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2004.
