- 1 The annual license fee for a Class B license obtained under this (v) 2 paragraph is \$2,500. A Class B license obtained under this paragraph does not confer (vi) 4 off-sale privileges. 5 (vii) The residency requirements under § 9-101 of this title apply to 6 an applicant for a Class B license under this paragraph. 7 (viii) The limit on the maximum number of Class B beer, wine and 8 liquor licenses in the county under subsection (b) of this section applies to the 9 issuance of licenses under this paragraph.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 June 1, 2004.
