A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Out-of-State Licensees**
3 **PG 305-04**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the issuance of certain alcoholic beverages licenses in
5 Prince George's County to a person, corporation, or limited liability company
6 holding an alcoholic beverages license in another state or Washington, D.C.;
7 providing an exception for renewals of certain alcoholic beverages licenses;
8 making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to a prohibition on
9 issuance of certain alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County to
10 certain holders of alcoholic beverages licenses in another state or Washington,
11 D.C.

13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 9-102.

21 (b-3) (1) In Anne Arundel County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light
22 wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be [issued] ISSUED, except by way of
23 [renewal] RENEWAL, to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an
24 alcoholic [beverage] BEVERAGES license in any other state, or Washington, D.C.

25 (2) In Baltimore City, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or
26 beer, wine and liquor license may not be [issued] ISSUED, except by way of [renewal]
27 RENEWAL, to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic
28 [beverage] BEVERAGES license in any other state.

1 (3) In Baltimore County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine,
2 or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a
3 person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages
4 license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

5 (4) In Calvert County and St. Mary's County, a Class A or Class D beer,
6 beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way
7 of renewal, to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic
8 beverages license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

9 (5) In Charles County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light wine, or
10 beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to a person,
11 corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages license in any
12 other state or in Washington, D.C.

13 (6) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER
14 AND LIGHT WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED,
15 EXCEPT BY WAY OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY
16 COMPANY HOLDING AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IN ANY OTHER STATE OR
17 IN WASHINGTON, D.C.

18 [(6)] (7) In Washington County, a Class A or Class D beer, beer and light
19 wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued, except by way of renewal, to
20 a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an alcoholic beverages
21 license in any other state or in Washington, D.C.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2004.
