A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - State Supplement to Federal Impact Aid - Children with**
3 **Disabilities - Nonpublic Placement Students**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to distribute a State supplement to federal
5 impact aid for children with disabilities who are nonpublic placement students
6 to certain county boards of education each year under certain circumstances;
7 providing for the calculation of the State supplement; and generally relating to
8 a State supplement to federal impact aid for children with disabilities who are
9 nonpublic placement students.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Education**

18 5-202.

19 (1) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EACH YEAR THE
20 STATE SHALL DISTRIBUTE A STATE SUPPLEMENT TO FEDERAL IMPACT AID FOR
21 CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES WHO ARE NONPUBLIC PLACEMENT STUDENTS TO A
22 COUNTY BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION.

23 (2) THE STATE SUPPLEMENT TO FEDERAL IMPACT AID REQUIRED BY
24 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS EQUAL TO THE DIFFERENCE, IF ANY,
25 BETWEEN:

1 (I) THE BASIC SUPPORT PAYMENT DUE TO THE COUNTY BOARD
2 FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES WHO ARE NONPUBLIC PLACEMENT STUDENTS AS
3 PROVIDED IN 20 U.S.C. § 7703 USING STUDENT DATA FROM THE MOST RECENT YEAR
4 FOR WHICH DATA IS AVAILABLE; AND

5 (II) THE ACTUAL FEDERAL IMPACT AID PAYMENT RECEIVED BY
6 THE COUNTY BOARD FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES WHO ARE NONPUBLIC
7 PLACEMENT STUDENTS IN THE MOST RECENT YEAR FOR WHICH DATA IS AVAILABLE.

8 (3) A COUNTY BOARD IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE STATE
9 SUPPLEMENT TO FEDERAL IMPACT AID UNLESS THE COUNTY BOARD IS ELIGIBLE
10 FOR FEDERAL IMPACT AID UNDER 20 U.S.C. § 7703.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
12 effect June 1, 2004.
