- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 22 [(a)] In Garrett County licensees shall sell beer for cash only and no suit may
- 23 be maintained by any retail dealer against any person for beer which has been sold on
- 24 credit. It is unlawful for any licensee to allow any person not designated under §
- 25 1-102(a)(6) of this article to loaf or loiter about his place of business.
- 26 [(b) It is unlawful for any liquor licensee under this article to employ any
- 27 person under the age of 18 years.]

- 2 (b) In the following jurisdictions the specified exceptions to subsection (a) of 3 this section apply:
- 4 (8) (i) The provisions of this paragraph apply only in Garrett County.
- 5 (iv) A licensee may not employ a person under the age of 18 years to
- 6 handle alcoholic beverages.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 8 effect October 1, 2004.
