14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19(2)"Authorized user" means the owner of a handgun or a person20 authorized by the owner to possess and use the handgun.

 24 the device has been deactivated.
