- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "WORK RELEASE PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM THAT
- 17 ENABLES AN INMATE SENTENCED TO IMPRISONMENT IN A LOCAL CORRECTIONAL
- 18 FACILITY OR THE BALTIMORE CITY DETENTION CENTER TO:
- 19 (1) ATTEND A VOCATIONAL OR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION;
- 20 (2) WORK AT GAINFUL PRIVATE EMPLOYMENT; OR
- 21 (3) PARTICIPATE IN ANY OTHER TRAINING OR REHABILITATION
- 22 PROGRAM.
- 23 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, EACH COUNTY THAT
- 24 MAINTAINS ONE OR MORE LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES SHALL ESTABLISH
- 25 AND OPERATE A WORK RELEASE PROGRAM.

- 1 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND OPERATE A WORK RELEASE 2 PROGRAM IN BALTIMORE CITY.

- 4 October 1, 2004.
