4 5 6 7	FOR the purpose of altering a certain surcharge on certain fees, charges, and costs in certain civil cases in the circuit courts and the District Court of Maryland; and generally relating to certain surcharges deposited into the Maryland Legal Services Corporation Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 2 7-202. 3 (a) (1) The State Court Administrator shall determine the amount of all 4 court costs and charges for the circuit courts of the counties with the approval of the 5 Board of Public Works. The fees and charges shall be uniform throughout the State. The State Court Administrator, as part of the Administrator's 6 7 determination of the amount of court costs and charges in civil cases, shall assess a 8 surcharge that: 9 May not be more than [\$10] \$40 \$20 per case; and $\{(1)\}$ (I) 10 $\{(2)\}$ (II)Shall be deposited into the Maryland Legal Services 11 Corporation Fund established under § 7-408 of this title. 12 7-301. 13 (1) The filing fees and costs in a civil case are those prescribed by law (c) 14 subject to modification by law, rule, or administrative regulation. 15 (2) The Chief Judge of the District Court shall assess a surcharge that: May not be more than: 16 (i) \$5 PER SUMMARY EJECTMENT CASE; AND 17 1. 18 2. [\$2] \$17 \$7 per [civil] case FOR ALL OTHER CIVIL CASES; 19 and 20 (ii) Shall be deposited into the Maryland Legal Services 21 Corporation Fund established under § 7-408 of this title. 22 The Court of Appeals may provide by rule for waiver of prepayment of 23 filing fees and other costs in cases of indigency. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 25 effect October 1, 2004.
