3 FOR the purpose of allowing participation in the State Police Deferred Retirement

- 4 Option Program (DROP) for certain members of the State Police Retirement
- 5 System; allowing participation in the Law Enforcement Officers' DROP for
- 6 certain members of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System; and
- 7 generally relating to the eligibility and participation requirements of the State
- 8 Police DROP and the Law Enforcement Officers' DROP.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
