- 8 the Maryland Center for Maternal and Child Health in the Family Health
- 9 Administration to provide the written information about shaken baby syndrome
- 10 to certain hospitals; providing for the contents of the written information;
- 11 requiring the written information to be in English and Spanish; specifying that
- 12 <u>failure to meet the requirements may of this Act not be construed to create a</u>
- 13 private right of action; and generally relating to hospitals providing information
- about shaken baby syndrome to maternity patients.
