1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County - Property Tax Credit - Village of Waugh Chapel**

3 FOR the purpose of providing for a tax credit in Anne Arundel County against the
4 county property tax for certain property owned by the Village Commons
5 Community Center, Incorporated; providing for the application of this Act; and
6 generally relating to a property tax credit in Anne Arundel County for certain
7 property owned by the Village Commons Community Center, Incorporated.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Tax - Property**

16 9-303.

17 (c) The governing body of Anne Arundel County shall grant a property tax
18 credit under this section against county property tax imposed on:

19 (1) real property that is owned by the Davidsonville Ruritan Foundation,
20 Incorporated; AND

21 (2) REAL PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY THE VILLAGE COMMONS
22 COMMUNITY CENTER, INCORPORATED, AND KNOWN AS THE VILLAGE OF WAUGH
23 CHAPEL.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
25 effect June 1, 2004, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June
26 30, 2004.
