- 7 and distribution of a certain form; requiring a county board to submit copies of a
- 8 certain form to the State Board of Education on or before a certain date each
- 9 year; requiring a county board to delete identifying information from certain
- 10 forms under certain circumstances; requiring the State Board to submit a
- 11 certain report on or before a certain date each year to certain committees
- 12 consisting of certain information relating to victim of harassment or
- intimidation reports filed with county boards; and generally relating to
- reporting incidents of harassment or intimidation of students at public schools.

- 24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "HARASSMENT OR INTIMIDATION" MEANS CONDUCT,
- 25 INCLUDING VERBAL CONDUCT, THAT:
- 26 (1) CREATES, OR CERTAINLY WILL CREATE, A HOSTILE EDUCATIONAL
- 27 ENVIRONMENT BY SUBSTANTIALLY INTERFERING WITH A STUDENT'S EDUCATIONAL
- 28 BENEFITS, OPPORTUNITIES, OR PERFORMANCE, OR WITH A STUDENT'S PHYSICAL OR
- 29 PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING AND IS:

(C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL CREATE A VICTIM OF HARASSMENT OR 13 (1) 14 INTIMIDATION REPORT FORM. EACH VICTIM OF HARASSMENT OR INTIMIDATION REPORT FORM 15 (2) 16 SHALL: 17 (I) IDENTIFY THE VICTIM AND THE PERPETRATOR, IF KNOWN: 18 (II)INDICATE THE AGE OF THE VICTIM AND PERPETRATOR: 19 (III) DESCRIBE THE INCIDENT, INCLUDING STATEMENTS MADE BY 20 THE ALLEGED PERPETRATOR; 21 (IV) INDICATE THE LOCATION OF THE INCIDENT; 22 IDENTIFY ANY PHYSICAL INJURY SUFFERED BY THE VICTIM (V) 23 AND DESCRIBE THE SERIOUSNESS AND ANY PERMANENT EFFECTS OF THE INJURY; IDENTIFY ANY REQUEST FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES 24 (VI) 25 INITIATED BY THE VICTIM OR THE VICTIM'S FAMILY DUE TO PSYCHOLOGICAL 26 INJURIES SUFFERED; AND (VII) DESCRIBE THE CORRECTIVE ACTION THE VICTIM WOULD LIKE 27 28 TO OCCUR. ## **HOUSE BILL 740**

1 (D) (1) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL SUBMIT COPIES OF ALL THE VICTIM OF 2 HARASSMENT OR INTIMIDATION REPORT FORMS FILED WITH THE COUNTY BOARD 3 TO THE STATE BOARD ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31 EACH YEAR. A COUNTY BOARD SHALL DELETE ANY INFORMATION THAT 5 IDENTIFIES AN INDIVIDUAL. THE STATE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT ON OR BEFORE MARCH 6 (E) (1) 7 31 EACH YEAR TO THE SENATE EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND ENVIRONMENTAL 8 AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE. IN 9 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, CONSISTING OF 10 A COMPILATION OF THE INFORMATION INCLUDED IN THE VICTIM OF HARASSMENT 11 OR INTIMIDATION REPORT FORMS FILED WITH THE COUNTY BOARDS THE PREVIOUS 12 YEAR. 13 (2) THE REPORT SUBMITTED BY THE STATE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE: 14 A DESCRIPTION OF THE ACT CONSTITUTING THE HARASSMENT 15 OR INTIMIDATION: THE AGE OF THE VICTIM AND PERPETRATOR; 16 (II)TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE, A DETERMINATION OF THE 17 (III)18 PERPETRATOR'S MOTIVE; 19 (IV) A DESCRIPTION OF THE INVESTIGATION OF THE COMPLAINT 20 AND ANY CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN BY THE APPROPRIATE SCHOOL AUTHORITIES; A STATISTICAL BREAKOUT OF THE NUMBER OF FALSE (V) 21 22 ALLEGATIONS REPORTED; AND
