4 FOR the purpose of requiring a person who is convicted of stopping, standing, or

- 5 parking a vehicle where prohibited by an official sign, while operating a
- 6 commercial motor vehicle in Anne Arundel County, to be assessed a certain
- 7 number of points; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to disqualify a
- 8 person from driving a commercial motor vehicle for a certain period of time if
- 9 the person is charged with stopping, standing, or parking a vehicle where
- 10 prohibited by an official sign, while operating a commercial motor vehicle in
- 11 Anne Arundel County, under certain circumstances; establishing a certain
- 12 penalty for the first and subsequent convictions of stopping, standing, or

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
9 MARYLAND, That Sections 16-402(a)(11) through (37) and 16-812(j) through (p),
10 respectively, of Article - Transportation of the Annotated Code of Maryland be
11 renumbered to be Sections 16-402(a)(12) through (38) and 16-812(k) through (q),

25 (J) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DISQUALIFY A PERSON FROM DRIVING 26 A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE FOR A PERIOD OF 30 DAYS IF THE PERSON IS:

27 (I) CHARGED WITH COMMITTING A VIOLATION OF § 21-1003(J) OF
28 THIS ARTICLE, WHILE OPERATING A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN ANNE
29 ARUNDEL COUNTY, THREE TIMES WITHIN A 180-DAY PERIOD; AND

(II) CONVICTED OF ALL THREE VIOLATIONS.

(II) IS SUBSEQUENTLY CHARGED WITH COMMITTING A VIOLATION

6 (j) A person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle at any place where 7 stopping is prohibited by an official sign.

9 (W) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF COMMITTING A VIOLATION OF § 10 21-1003(J) OF THIS ARTICLE WHILE OPERATING A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN 11 ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY IS SUBJECT TO:

12 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE OF \$100;

13 (2) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, A FINE OF \$250; AND

14 (3) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE OF \$500.

15 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 June 1, 2004.
