1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Wicomico County - Catering License - Class B Beer and Light Wine**
3 **Licensees**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Wicomico County Board of License
5 Commissioners to issue a caterer's license for a certain fee to the holder of a
6 Class B restaurant or hotel (on-sale) beer and light wine license; authorizing a
7 holder of a Class B beer and light wine catering license to provide beer and light
8 wine at certain events off the Class B licensed premises; establishing the hours
9 and days for sale for a Class B beer and light wine catering license; requiring
10 that a holder of a Class B beer and light wine catering license serve food at a
11 catered event; clarifying that a catering license is not required for catering on
12 Class B beer and light wine licensed premises; making a stylistic change;
13 making a technical correction; and generally relating to a Class B beer and light
14 wine catering license.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

2 6-709.

3 (a) (1) This section applies only in Wicomico County.

4 (2) In this section, "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners.

5 (b) The annual license fee is \$550.

6 (c) (1) The Board may issue a caterer's license.

7 (2) If a caterer's license is issued, it shall only be issued to a holder of
8 [a]:9 (I) A CLASS B RESTAURANT OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER AND LIGHT
10 WINE LICENSE; OR11 (II) A Class B restaurant or hotel (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor
12 license.

13 (d) A caterer's license issued under this section authorizes [the holder]:

14 (1) THE HOLDER OF A CLASS B BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE TO
15 PROVIDE BEER AND LIGHT WINE AT EVENTS THAT ARE HELD OFF THE CLASS B
16 RESTAURANT OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSED PREMISES;
17 AND18 (2) THE HOLDER OF A CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE to
19 provide alcoholic beverages at events that are held off the Class B restaurant or hotel
20 (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor [license] LICENSED premises.21 (e) The holder shall provide food as well as alcoholic beverages for
22 consumption at the catered event.23 (f) A holder may exercise the privileges under this license only during the
24 hours and days that are [permitted in] ALLOWED UNDER this article for [a Class B
25 restaurant or hotel (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license] THE UNDERLYING CLASS
26 B LICENSE.27 (g) This section does not require a holder of an existing CLASS B RESTAURANT
28 OR HOTEL (ON-SALE) BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE OR A Class B restaurant or
29 hotel (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license to have a caterer's license for catering on
30 the premises that is covered by the Class B license.31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
32 June 1, 2004.
