3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

4 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 5-1411 of Article 83A - Business and Economic

5 Development of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 6 5-1412.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 8 read as follows:

Article 83A - Business and Economic Development

10 5-1411.

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11 (A) (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS 12 SUBTITLE THAT EXCEEDS \$100,000.

(2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE USED
 SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING REAL PROPERTY OR STRUCTURES ON
 REAL PROPERTY.

16 (B) WITH RESPECT TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO A 17 LOCAL GOVERNMENT:

(1) IF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT HAS A PROGRAM FOR PROMOTING
 PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES AMONG MINORITY BUSINESSES THAT IS
 ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SHALL APPLY THE
 REQUIREMENTS OF THAT PROGRAM TO THE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS OR SERVICES
 MADE WITH THE PROCEEDS FROM THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE; BUT

(2) IF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DOES NOT HAVE A PROGRAM THAT IS
ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT IS SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.

26 (C) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE" MEANS:

27 (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS A SOCIAL OR ECONOMIC 28 IMPEDIMENT THAT:

I. IS BEYOND THE PERSONAL CONTROL OF THE INDIVIDUAL,
 SUCH AS FINANCIAL CAPACITY, GEOGRAPHICAL OR REGIONAL ECONOMIC DISTRESS,
 OR LACK OF FORMAL EDUCATION; AND

(II) A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT IS AT LEAST 51% OWNED AND
 CONTROLLED BY INDIVIDUALS WHO MEET THE STANDARDS UNDER ITEM (I) OF THIS

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(2) WITH RESPECT TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE
 TO AN ENTITY OTHER THAN A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE ENTITY SHALL AGREE TO
 INCLUDE IN THE AGREEMENT PROVIDING THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE A PROVISION
 ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT WOULD ENCOURAGE THE PROCUREMENT
 FROM MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES OF GOODS OR SERVICES PURCHASED WITH
 THE PROCEEDS FROM THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

7 (3) IN NEGOTIATING THE PROVISION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)
8 OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TAKE INTO ACCOUNT RELEVANT

10(I)THE INTENDED USE OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE FINANCIAL11ASSISTANCE; AND

12 (II) THE FEASIBILITY OF OBTAINING THE REQUIRED GOODS OR 13 SERVICES FROM MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES.

14 (D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE THAT A RECIPIENT OF FINANCIAL

16 UPDATED LIST, OF THE MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES FROM WHICH GOODS OR
17 SERVICES WERE PROCURED AND THE NATURE AND DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE GOODS
18 OR SERVICES.

21 (Q) (1) (I) IN THIS SUBSECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 22 MEANINGS INDICATED.

(II) "FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE" MEANS A GRANT, LOAN, OR
 INVESTMENT PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION THAT EXCEEDS \$100,000.

PROMOTING PROCUREMENT OPPORTUNITIES AMONG MINORITY BUSINESSES THAT
IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL APPLY THE REQUIREMENTS OF THAT PROGRAM
TO THE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS OR SERVICES MADE WITH THE PROCEEDS FROM
THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE; BUT

38 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of
 39 Business and Economic Development shall report, on or before September 1 of each

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- year, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article to the Joint
 Committee on Fair Practices on the results of the implementation of the provisions of 3 this Act.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 5 January 1, 2005.
