RIGHT TO FARM. 4 237. <u>18-101.</u> (A) 5 SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF 6 ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY MAY ADOPT AN ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR 7 REGULATION OR TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION THAT THE COUNTY COUNCIL CONSIDERS 8 NECESSARY TO PROTECT A PERSON'S RIGHT TO FARM OR ENGAGE IN AGRICULTURAL 9 OR FORESTRY OPERATIONS. 10 (B) BEFORE ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION, OR REGULATION OR 11 TAKING OTHER ACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY 12 COUNCIL SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING AND PROVIDE REASONABLE NOTICE OF 13 THE HEARING. 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
