21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

## 6 (I) AT LEAST ONE APPOINTED VOTING MEMBER SHALL POSSESS A HIGH 7 LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERTISE CONCERNING BUDGET AND FINANCE.

 9 one member shall also possess knowledge or experience in the education of children 10 with disabilities.(2) The knowledge or experience may be derived from being the parent of 12 a child with a disability.

(2) VOTING MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT, AFTER 5 SUBMITTING VOUCHERS, FOR TRAVEL AND OTHER EXPENSES.

6 (3) A STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION, BUT 7 AFTER SUBMITTING EXPENSE VOUCHERS, MAY BE REIMBURSED FOR TRAVEL AND 8 OTHER EXPENSES.
