17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 9-1801 through 9-1812, inclusive, and the subtitle
19 "Subtitle 18. Council on Management and Productivity" of Article - State Government
20 of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
22 read as follows:

23 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

24 13-107.1.

25 (c) (1) There is an interagency panel consisting of representatives appointed
26 by the Governor from the following:

- 1 (i) the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- 2 (ii) the Department of Human Resources;
- 3 (iii) the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation;
- 4 (iv) the Department of Juvenile Services;
- 5 (v) the Office for Individuals with Disabilities;
- 6 (vi) the Department of Aging; AND
- 7 (vii) the Department of Business and Economic Development [; and
- 8 (viii) the Council on Management and Productivity].

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2004.
