stamp; providing for a group license for organized fox chasing associations;

To hunt migratory game birds the purchaser must also buy a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and to hunt wild waterfowl the purchaser must buy both a Maryland migratory game bird stamp and a federal migratory bird hunting and conservation stamp. IN ORDER TO HUNT FURBEARING MAMMALS THE PURCHASER MUST ALSO PURCHASE A FURBEARER STAMP. To hunt deer during bow and arrow season and black powder season the purchaser must also purchase a bow and arrow or black powder stamp.



THE PURCHASER MUST ALSO PURCHASE A FURBEARER STAMP TO HUNT FURBEARING MAMMALS WITH THIS LICENSE. Under no circumstance does this license authorize the purchaser to hunt deer and turkey.



- 2 (a) A club or association may not hold a field trial with dogs in the State
- 3 during any closed hunting season without first obtaining a permit from the Secretary.
- 4 (b) The Secretary may grant a permit to field trial clubs and associations to
- 5 hold field trials with raccoon, opossum, bird, or rabbit dogs in the State any time
- 6 during the closed season. Field trials shall be held pursuant to regulations the
- 7 Secretary adopts to safeguard the interests of wildlife in the State.
- 8 (C) A PERSON ENGAGED IN AN ORGANIZED FIELD TRIAL THAT HAS RECEIVED
- 9 A PERMIT FROM THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS EXEMPT FROM THE
- 10 HUNTING LICENSE AND STAMP REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 12 effect July 1, 2004.
