- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article - Business Regulation

- 21 (a) A licensee shall display a license in the way that the Comptroller requires
- 22 by regulation.
- 23 (b) A licensee who sells cigarettes through a vending machine:

	(1) shall place each package of cigarettes in the machine so that when the package is visible the tax stamps required by § 12-304 of the Tax - General Article are also visible; and
4	(2) in the way that the Comptroller requires by regulation, shall:
5 6	(i) identify each vending machine with a conspicuous label that states the licensee's name, address, and telephone number; and
7 8	(ii) display on a conspicuous label applicable prohibitions and penalties under § 10-107 of the Criminal Law Article.
11	(C) (1) A LICENSED RETAILER MAY NOT DISPLAY OR STORE TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN A PLACE THAT IS ACCESSIBLE TO A PURCHASER WITHOUT THE INTERVENTION OF THE LICENSED RETAILER OR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LICENSED RETAILER UNLESS THE EXCEPTION IN § 16-3A-02 OF THIS TITLE IS MET.
	(2) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PREEMPT THE ENACTMENT OR ENFORCEMENT OF LOCAL ORDINANCES RESTRICTING THE DISPLAY OR STORAGE OF A TOBACCO PRODUCT.

17 18	A person may not sell or dispense or offer to sell or dispense a tobacco product through a vending machine in the State, unless the vending machine:
19 20	(1) is located in an establishment that minors are prohibited by law from entering or an establishment that is a bona fide fraternal or veterans organization; or
	(2) can only be operated with a token, card, or similar device that an individual can only obtain or purchase from the owner or an employee or agent of the owner.
