- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Health General
- 17 19-308.7.
- 18 EACH HOSPITAL LICENSED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE THAT OFFERS A MEDICAL
- 19 RESIDENCY EDUCATION PROGRAM SHALL:
- 20 (1) COMPLY WITH THE DUTY HOUR REQUIREMENTS FOR MEDICAL
- 21 RESIDENTS AND INTERNS ESTABLISHED BY THE ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR
- 22 GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION; AND
- 23 (2) DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT POLICIES THAT PROVIDE MEDICAL
- 24 RESIDENTS AND INTERNS WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO SLEEP FOR A MINIMUM OF 4
- 25 HOURS WITHIN EACH 24-HOUR TIME PERIOD THAT THE RESIDENT OR INTERN IS ON
- 26 DUTY.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 28 October 1, 2004.
