BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 4 **Article - Health Occupations** 5 17-101. 6 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated. 7 "Appraisal" means: (c) (1) 8 (i) Selecting, administering, scoring, and interpreting 9 STANDARDIZED instruments designed to assess an individual's aptitudes, attitudes, 10 abilities, achievements, interests, and personal characteristics; and 11 Using [nonstandardized] COUNSELING AND THERAPY methods 12 and techniques for understanding human behavior in relation to coping with, 13 adapting to, or changing life situations. 14 "Appraisal" does not include TESTS OR instruments which require 15 specialized psychological training for administration and interpretation [unless the 16 licensed or certified professional counselor has completed training deemed by the 17 Board of Examiners of Psychologists and the State Board of Professional Counselors 18 and Therapists to be equivalent to that of a licensed psychologist who is qualified to 19 administer the same types of instruments]. 20 "STANDARDIZED" MEANS THE USE OF CONSISTENT INSTRUCTIONS, (O) 21 MATERIALS, AND ACTIONS TO ENSURE AN INSTRUMENT IS ADMINISTERED IN A 22 PRECISE MANNER REGARDLESS OF THE EXAMINER OR EXAMINEE. 23 "STANDARDIZED TEST" MEANS A TEST THAT IS ADMINISTERED UNDER 24 CONSISTENT CONDITIONS TO A REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLE OF PARTICIPANTS FOR 25 THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A MEASURE OF NORMAL OR AVERAGE PERFORMANCE. 26 17-3A-02. 27 (a) To qualify for licensing, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the 28 applicable requirements of this section. 29 The applicant shall be of good moral character. (b) 30 (c) The applicant shall be at least 18 years old.
