13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Election Law

16 13-215.

17 (a) Each chairman, treasurer, subtreasurer, and campaign manager shall be a 18 registered voter of the State.

- 19 (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a candidate may not act:
- 20 (i) as the treasurer or subtreasurer of a campaign finance entity of

21 the candidate; or

- 22 (ii) with respect to any other campaign finance entity:
- 23 1. as the campaign manager, treasurer, or subtreasurer; or
- 24 2. in any other position that exercises general overall
- 25 responsibility for the conduct of the entity.

	(2) (I) An incumbent member of a central committee who is a candidate for election to party office may act as the treasurer of that central committee.
	(II) WITH RESPECT TO ANY CAMPAIGN FINANCE ENTITY OTHER THAN THE CANDIDATE'S OWN CAMPAIGN FINANCE ENTITY, A CANDIDATE FOR DELEGATE TO THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION MAY ACT:
7 8	1. AS THE CAMPAIGN MANAGER, TREASURER, OR SUBTREASURER; OR
9 10	2. IN ANY OTHER POSITION THAT EXERCISES GENERAL OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ENTITY.
11	(c) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the chairman, treasurer,

- 12 subtreasurer, or campaign manager of a campaign finance entity may serve as the 13 chairman, treasurer, subtreasurer, or campaign manager of another campaign
- 14 finance entity.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 15 16 effect July 1, 2004.
