A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education - Community Colleges - Students with a Documented**
3 **Disability**

4 FOR the purpose of allocating a grant in a certain amount to the Maryland Higher
5 Education Commission to be distributed to community college boards and to the
6 Baltimore City Community College Board of Trustees on a certain basis;
7 requiring the boards and the Board of Trustees to use the funds for a certain
8 purpose; requiring the Commission, in consultation with the Maryland
9 Association of Community Colleges, to adopt certain regulations for the
10 administration of the grant; and generally relating to the funding of services
11 and programs for students with a documented disability at both community
12 colleges and the Baltimore City Community College.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Education**

21 16-305.

22 (G) (1) (I) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2006, AND EACH FISCAL YEAR
23 THEREAFTER, A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500,000 SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE
24 COMMISSION FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE BOARDS OF EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE
25 AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN
26 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION.

27 (II) THE COMMISSION SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE GRANT ON A PER
28 STUDENT BASIS, FOR EACH STUDENT WITH A DOCUMENTED DISABILITY, AS

1 DEFINED BY THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT, WHO ATTENDS COMMUNITY
2 COLLEGE OR THE BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

3 (III) THE BOARDS AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
4 BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL USE THE FUNDS DISTRIBUTED
5 UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH TO MEET THE SPECIAL SERVICES
6 AND EQUIPMENT NEEDS OF A STUDENT WITH A DOCUMENTED DISABILITY WHO
7 ATTENDS THE COLLEGE.

8 (2) (I) MONEY THAT IS APPROPRIATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF
9 THIS SUBSECTION THAT IS NOT USED BY THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR MAY NOT
10 REVERT TO THE STATE TREASURY.

11 (II) ALL MONEY RETAINED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
12 SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED TO MAKE AWARDS TO STUDENTS WITH A
13 DOCUMENTED DISABILITY AT THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE LEVEL DURING
14 SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS AND MAY NOT BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE
15 PURPOSES.

16 (III) A BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY NOT TRANSFER STATE FUNDS
17 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO ANY OTHER PROGRAM OR CATEGORY.

18 (3) THE COMMISSION, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND
19 ASSOCIATION FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE
20 ADMINISTRATION OF THE GRANT.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 July 1, 2004.
