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## **Election Law - Campaign Contributions - Receipts**

3 FOR the purpose of amending altering the amount of money each person may

- 4 contribute for a campaign event that will require a campaign contribution
- 5 receipt; providing a certain exception; authorizing a treasurer or subtreasurer to
- 6 report certain contributions as a lump sum; providing that a treasurer or

7 subtreasurer does not have to complete a campaign contribution receipt for

8 certain campaign contributions if a certain amount of campaign contributions

9 are received during a certain period of time; requiring a treasurer or

10 subtreasurer to complete a campaign contribution receipt for certain campaign

11 contributions if a certain amount of campaign contributions are received during

12 a certain period of time; and generally relating to the completion of campaign

13 contribution receipts.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

	(a) (1) On receiving and before depositing a contribution specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a treasurer or subtreasurer shall issue a campaign contribution receipt on the form that the State Board prescribes.

20 21 22 23	(5) <u>A CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION RECEIPT IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE</u> ISSUED TO A PERSON WHO PURCHASES ONE OR MORE TICKETS FOR A CAMPAIGN EVENT AT A COST OF NOT LESS THAN \$21 NOR MORE THAN \$51, BUT THE TREASURER OR SUBTREASURER OF THE CAMPAIGN FINANCE ENTITY FROM WHICH THE TICKETS WERE PURCHASED SHALL INCLUDE THE NAME AND OTHER INFORMATION FOR THE CONTRIBUTORS OF THOSE CONTRIBUTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 13-304 OF THIS TITLE ON ITS CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORT.
