14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (f) (1) For fiscal year 2004, the State share of the foundation program shall
19 be adjusted to reflect regional differences in the cost of education that are due to
20 factors outside the control of local jurisdictions, by increasing the State share of the
21 foundation program otherwise determined for the following counties by:
(i) $1 \%$ for Anne Arundel County;
(ii) $3 \%$ for Baltimore City;
(iii) $3 \%$ for Howard County; and
(iv) $4 \%$ for Montgomery County.

2 (2) (I) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005, THE STATE BUDGET SHALL INCLUDE
$3 \$ 47,400,000$ TO REFLECT REGIONAL DIFFERENCES IN THE COST OF EDUCATION THAT
4 ARE DUE TO FACTORS OUTSIDE THE CONTROL OF LOCAL JURISDICTIONS.

(II) For fiscal year [2005] 2006 and each fiscal year thereafter, the 6 State share of the foundation program shall be adjusted to reflect regional differences
7 in the cost of education that are due to factors outside the control of local jurisdictions,
8 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS

(3) The Department shall contract with a private entity to conduct a

(i) Develop a Maryland specific geographic cost of education index

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
17 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
18 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
19 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
20 effect from the date it is enacted.
