- 2 Real Property Sales - Disclosure Requirements - Chesapeake and Atlantic 3 **Coastal Bays Critical Area**
- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring a contract or an addendum to a contract for the sale of
- real property to contain a certain statement advising the buyer that the 5
- 6 property may be located in the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Critical
- 7 Area, that certain regulations apply to certain land in the critical area, and that
- a buyer may determine if critical area regulations apply by contacting certain 8
- local officials; and generally relating to disclosure requirements for the sale of 9
- 10 real property.

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 3 Article - Real Property

- 4 14-117.
- 5 (d) (1) A contract for use in the sale of residential property used as a
- 6 dwelling place for one or two single-family units shall contain, in the manner
- 7 provided under [subsection (e) of this section] PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
- 8 the following statement:
- 9 "Section 14-104 of the Real Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland
- 10 provides that, unless otherwise negotiated in the contract or provided by State or local
- 11 law, the cost of any recordation tax or any State or local transfer tax shall be shared
- 12 equally between the buyer and seller."
- 13 [(e)] (2) The statement required under [subsection (d) of this section]
- 14 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION shall be printed in conspicuous type or
- 15 handwritten in the contract or an addendum to the contract.
- 16 (E) A CONTRACT OR AN ADDENDUM TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF
- 17 REAL PROPERTY SHALL CONTAIN IN CONSPICUOUS TYPE ON A SEPARATE PIECE OF
- 18 PAPER THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT:
- 19 "NOTICE TO BUYER CONCERNING THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ATLANTIC
- 20 COASTAL BAYS CRITICAL AREA
- 21 BUYER IS ADVISED THAT ALL OR A PORTION OF THE PROPERTY MAY BE
- 22 LOCATED IN THE "CRITICAL AREA" OF THE CHESAPEAKE AND ATLANTIC COASTAL
- 23 BAYS, AND THAT ADDITIONAL ZONING, LAND USE, AND RESOURCE PROTECTION
- 24 REGULATIONS APPLY IN THIS AREA. THE "CRITICAL AREA" GENERALLY CONSISTS OF
- 25 ALL LAND AND WATER AREAS WITHIN 1,000 FEET BEYOND THE LANDWARD
- 26 BOUNDARIES OF STATE OR PRIVATE WETLANDS, THE CHESAPEAKE BAY, THE
- 27 ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS, AND ALL OF THEIR TIDAL TRIBUTARIES. THE "CRITICAL
- 28 AREA" ALSO INCLUDES THE WATERS OF AND LANDS UNDER THE CHESAPEAKE BAY,
- 29 THE ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS, AND ALL OF THEIR TIDAL TRIBUTARIES TO THE HEAD
- 30 OF TIDE. FOR INFORMATION AS TO WHETHER THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED WITHIN
- 31 THE CRITICAL AREA, BUYER MAY CONTACT THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING
- 32 AND ZONING, WHICH MAINTAINS MAPS SHOWING THE EXTENT OF THE CRITICAL
- 33 AREA IN THE JURISDICTION. ALLEGANY, CARROLL, FREDERICK, GARRETT, HOWARD,
- 34 MONTGOMERY, AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES DO NOT INCLUDE LAND LOCATED IN
- 35 THE CRITICAL AREA.".
- 36 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 37 October 1, 2004.
