11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13	Article - Criminal Law
14	10-114.
15	An individual under the age of 21 years may not:
18 19	(1) possess or have under the individual's charge or control an alcoholic beverage unless the individual is a bona fide employee of the license holder as defined in Article 2B, § 1-102 of the Code and the alcoholic beverage is in the possession or under the charge or control of the individual in the course of the individual's employment and during regular working hours; OR
21 22	(2) CONSUME ALCOHOL AND EXHIBIT EFFECTS OF ITS CONSUMPTION, SUCH AS HAVING BOTH:
23 24	(I) THE ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ON THE INDIVIDUAL'S BREATH; AND
25	(II) IMPAIRED SPEECH APPEARANCE OR REHAVIOR

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2004.
