1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Business Regulation - Vending Machines**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision that exempts the sale or offering for
4 sale of cigarettes, newspapers, magazines, paper cups, paper or cloth towels,
5 soap, toilet seat covers, postage stamps, or sanitary napkins from the
6 requirements of certain provisions of law regulating vending machines; and
7 generally relating to the regulation of vending machines.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Business Regulation**

16 [17-1902.

17 This subtitle does not apply to the sale or offering for sale of cigarettes,
18 newspapers, magazines, paper cups, paper or cloth towels, soap, toilet seat covers,
19 postage stamps, or sanitary napkins.]

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2004.
