- 1 (D) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2006, ANY SUBSIDY RECEIVED BY THE STATE
- 2 THAT IS PROVIDED TO EMPLOYERS AS A RESULT OF THE FEDERAL MEDICARE
- 3 PRESCRIPTION DRUG, IMPROVEMENT, AND MODERNIZATION ACT OF 2003, SHALL BE
- 4 DEPOSITED INTO THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH
- 5 FUNDING SYSTEM.
- 6 (E) THE ASSETS OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH FUNDING SYSTEM SHALL
- 7 BE INVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THOSE OF THE OTHER SYSTEMS OF THE

- 21 (H) IF FOR ANY REASON THE STATE DISCONTINUES THE POSTRETIREMENT
- 22 HEALTH INSURANCE SUBSIDY SPECIFIED IN § 2-508 OF THIS ARTICLE OR A
- 23 SUCCESSOR SUBSIDY, THE ASSETS OF THE POSTRETIREMENT HEALTH FUNDING
- 24 SYSTEM SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND.
