State Board of Glass Technician Examiners - Licensure and Regulation

- 3 FOR the purpose of creating the State Board of Glass Technician Examiners in the
- Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation; providing for the composition, 4
- 5 appointment, terms, and expenses of the Board members; authorizing the Board
- 6 to sue in the name of the State, with the permission of the Attorney General, to
- 7 enjoin certain conduct; establishing certain powers and duties of the Board;
- 8 requiring the Board to maintain certain records; requiring the Board to pay all
- money into the General Fund of the State; requiring certain persons to be 9
- 10 licensed by the Board before an individual may provide automotive glass work
- or glazing services in the State; establishing certain education, experience, and 11
- 12 examination requirements for automotive glass work technicians and glaziers;
- 13 establishing certain requirements for qualifying, renewing, reinstating, and
- 14 surrendering a license for automotive glass technicians and glaziers; providing
- 15 for the reciprocity of a license with other states; requiring a licensee to provide
- 16 the Board notice of certain changes within a certain time frame; authorizing the
- 17 Board to deny a license to an applicant, refuse to renew a license, reprimand a
- 18 licensee, suspend or revoke a license, or impose certain penalties under certain
- 19 circumstances; establishing certain hearing and appeal procedures for
- 20 automotive glass technicians and glaziers; prohibiting certain persons from
- performing the functions of an automotive glass technician or glazier unless 21
- 22 licensed by the Board; prohibiting certain persons from misrepresenting an
- 23 individual's status of licensure as an automotive glass technician or glazier by
- the Board; providing for certain criminal penalties; requiring that an evaluation 24
- 25 of the Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be
- performed on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; specifying the 26
- 27 terms of the initial members of the Board; providing for status of individuals
- 28 providing automotive glass work or glazing services on or before a certain date;
- 29 providing for the qualifications of the initial members of the Board; requiring
- 30 the Board to submit a certain report to certain committees of the General
- 31 Assembly on or before a certain date; making certain technical corrections; and
- 32 generally relating to the State Board of Glass Technician Examiners and
- 33 licensing and regulation of automotive glass technicians and glaziers.
