BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 Article - Health - General 16 15-303. 17 The Department shall: (a) (1) 18 (I) [be] BE responsible for enrolling program recipients in 19 managed care organizations under the Maryland Children's Health Program 20 established under §§ 15-301 and 15-301.1 of this subtitle; AND ALLOW AN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL WHOSE FAMILY INCOME IS 21 (II)22 ABOVE 200 PERCENT BUT AT OR BELOW 300 PERCENT OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY 23 GUIDELINES TO REENROLL IN MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS UNDER THE 24 MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM AFTER A 6-MONTH PERIOD WITHOUT 25 COVERAGE.
