- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 **Article - Environment**
- 14 7-238.
- 15 Unless it is renewed for another term, a facility permit expires on the (a) (1) expiration date the Department specifies at issuance or renewal.
- 17 (2) Unless the controlled hazardous substance facility is a low-level
- 18 nuclear waste facility, the Department may not issue a facility permit for a term
- 19 longer than [5] 10 years. The Department may issue a low-level nuclear waste
- 20 facility permit for a term not longer than 5 years.
- 21 (b) The Department may renew a facility permit if the permit holder:
- 22 (1)Has complied with all appropriate rules and regulations;
- 23 (2) Pays to the Department the renewal fee set by the Department; and
- 24 (3) Submits to the Department a renewal application on the form the
- 25 Department requires.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2004.
