- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 Article Family Law

- 23 (d) The final protective order may include any or all of the following relief:
- 24 (11) direct the respondent or any or all of the persons eligible for relief to
- 25 participate in professionally supervised counseling or a domestic violence program;

- 1 (12) order the respondent to surrender to law enforcement authorities any
- 2 firearm in the respondent's possession for the duration of the protective order; or
- 3 4-509.
- 4 (a) A person who fails to comply with the relief granted in an interim
- 5 protective order under § 4-504.1(c)(1), (2), (3), (4)(i), (7), or (8) of this subtitle, a
- 6 temporary protective order under § 4-505(a)(2)(i), (ii), (iii), (iv), or (v) of this subtitle,
- 7 or a final protective order under § 4-506(d)(1), (2), (3), (4), [or] (5), OR (12) OF THIS
- 8 SUBTITLE, OR A RESPONDENT WHO WILLFULLY FAILS TO COMPLETE COUNSELING
- 9 OR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM ORDERED UNDER § 4-506(D)(11) of this subtitle
- 10 is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject, for each offense, to:
- 11 (1) for a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not
- 12 exceeding 90 days or both; and
- 13 (2) for a second or subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$2,500 or
- 14 imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.
- 15 (b) An officer shall arrest with or without a warrant and take into custody a
- 16 person who the officer has probable cause to believe is in violation of an interim,
- 17 temporary, or final protective order in effect at the time of the violation.

- 19 October 1, 2004.
