A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Crimes - Obstructing or Hindering a Law Enforcement Officer

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from obstructing or hindering a law
- 4 enforcement officer in the performance of the law enforcement officer's duties,
- 5 whether intentionally or otherwise; establishing criminal penalties for
- 6 violations of this Act; and generally relating to the crimes of obstructing or
- 7 hindering a law enforcement officer.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Criminal Law

- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" HAS THE MEANING 18 STATED IN \S 3-101 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.
- 19 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT, BY ACT OR OMISSION, OBSTRUCT OR HINDER
- 20 ANOTHER KNOWING OR HAVING REASON TO KNOW THAT THE OTHER IS
- 21 PERFORMING OFFICIAL DUTIES AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
- 22 (C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
- 23 PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF THE MISDEMEANOR OF
- 24 OBSTRUCTING OR HINDERING A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE SECOND
- 25 DEGREE AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1
- 26 YEAR OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$3,000 OR BOTH.

- 1 (2) A PERSON WHO INTENTIONALLY VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY
- 2 OF THE FELONY OF OBSTRUCTION OR HINDERING A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN
- 3 THE FIRST DEGREE AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT
- 4 EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2004.
