- 18 (b) A recipient of an undergraduate or graduate senatorial scholarship may
- 19 hold the scholarship, appropriately prorated, for 8 academic years if he:
- 20 (1) Is a part-time student;
- 21 (2) Continues to be a resident of this State; and
- 22 (3) Continues to be a student at the institution and takes at least [6] 3
- 23 semester hours of courses each semester leading to a degree.

- 25 (a) A Delegate may award [2 part-time scholarships for each full-time 26 scholarship available] PART-TIME SCHOLARSHIPS.

- 1 (b) A part-time 2 a full-time scholarship. A part-time scholarship may not be for more than twice as many years as
