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

3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	FOR the purpose of establishing a Washington County Water and Sewer Infrastructure Commission; specifying the membership of the Commission and certain work groups within the Commission; specifying the duties of the Commission; providing for the staffing of the Commission; requiring the Commission to issue certain reports by certain dates to the Washington County Delegation, the Washington County Board of County Commissioners, and the Hagerstown City Council; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of a Washington County Water and Sewer Infrastructure Commission.

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	(g) The Washington County Board of County Commissioners, <u>and</u> the City of Hagerstown, and the Department of the Environment shall provide the staff for the Commission.

5 6	(1) assessing the existing capacity and deficiencies of the water and sewer services in Washington County;	
7 8	(2) reviewing the State and federal regulatory requirements with regard o providing water and sewer services;	
	(3) reviewing and analyzing the future growth projections for Washington County, and the impact that growth will have on water and sewer services throughout Washington County;	
12 13	(4) examining the water and sewer services provided by neighboring regions and other counties and municipalities throughout the State;

	(2) addresses how to meet Washington County's water and sewer needs through 2055, including the options of consolidation or regionalization of services, joint service agreements, or regional authorities.	

- 1 (j) The Commission shall submit an interim report of its findings to the
- 2 Washington County Delegation, the Washington County Board of County
- 3 Commissioners, and the Hagerstown City Council on or before January 1, 2005.
- 4 (k) The Commission shall submit a final report of its findings and
- 5 recommendations to the Washington County Delegation, the Washington County
- 6 Board of County Commissioners, and the Hagerstown City Council on or before June 7 30, 2006.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 July 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June
- 10 30, 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 11 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
