3 FOR the purpose of creating an additional exception to the prohibition on buying,

- 4 selling, shipping, transporting, or otherwise dealing in finfish without a certain

6 defining which species of finfish may be caught and sold as bait under certain

7 circumstances; and generally relating to bait species of finfish.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

16 4-702.

17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a person may not buy, sell, ship,

- 18 transport, or otherwise deal in finfish unless the person is licensed by the
- 19 Department.

20 (b) The following persons are not required to obtain a license under this 21 section:

1 (1) A person licensed by the Department to catch finfish for sale;

2 (2) A retail market, restaurant, or other establishment where finfish are 3 sold or served to ultimate consumers, and not for resale; [or]

4 (3) A person who buys finfish for personal use or consumption; AND

5 (4) A PERSON WHO CATCHES AND SELLS AS BAIT FINFISH SPECIES6 DEFINED AS BAIT UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.

7 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS DEFINING WHICH
8 SPECIES OF FINFISH MAY BE CAUGHT AND SOLD AS BAIT UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(4)
9 OF THIS SECTION.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2004.
