## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

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2 Calvert County - Conversion of a Nonprofit Organization to a Sanitary 3 **District** 

4 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain nonprofit organization established for

5 operating a public water system in Calvert County may petition the Secretary of

6 the Environment to convert to a sanitary district; providing that a vote on a

7 certain petition shall be conducted in a certain manner; specifying the contents

8 of a certain petition; requiring the Secretary to file a certain notice of conversion

with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation under certain

10 circumstances; providing that a certain nonprofit organization shall cease to

exist and all assets, liabilities, and the bylaws of the nonprofit organization

shall become the assets, liabilities, and bylaws of a certain sanitary district; 12

13 providing for the membership, terms, and duties of a certain sanitary

14 commission; requiring a certain sanitary commission to sign certain articles of

15 incorporation and file them with the State Department of Assessments and

16 Taxation; requiring the State Department of Assessments and Taxation to

17 receive certain articles of incorporation, mark the date and time of receipt on the

articles of incorporation, and issue a certain certificate of approval under certain

18 19 circumstances; providing that the name of a certain nonprofit organization and

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certain trade names shall remain in the name of a certain sanitary district until

21 changed by a certain order under certain circumstances; providing that all 22

rights, property, and existing obligations of a certain nonprofit organization

23 shall become the rights, property, and obligations of a certain sanitary district;

providing that title to certain property shall be vested in a certain sanitary 24

25 district and no reversion or impairment of ownership rights shall be caused by a

certain conversion; providing that the rights of a certain creditor may not be 26

27 impaired without the creditor's consent under certain circumstances; providing 28

that a certain sanitary district shall have the powers and duties of certain other

sanitary districts; stating the intent of the General Assembly; providing for the

30 termination of this Act; and generally relating to the conversion of a nonprofit

organization established for operating a public water system in Calvert County

ON FINAL APPROVAL OF THE PETITION BY THE SECRETARY, THE

34 SECRETARY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL FILE A NOTICE OF 35 CONVERSION WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION.

ON FILING THE NOTICE OF CONVERSION WITH THE STATE (2)2 DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION: (I) THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL CEASE TO EXIST AND 4 ALL ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL BECOME 5 THE ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE NEWLY ORGANIZED DISTRICT WITHOUT 6 FURTHER MEETINGS, VOTING, NOTICE TO CREDITORS, OR OTHER ACTIONS BY THE 7 MEMBERS OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION; AND THE BYLAWS OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL 8 (II)9 BECOME THE BYLAWS OF THE DISTRICT UNTIL CHANGED BY AN ORDER OF THE 10 SANITARY COMMISSION OF THE DISTRICT. 11 (E) (1) (I) THE DISTRICT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY A SANITARY 12 COMMISSION. 13 (II)THE SANITARY COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF NINE 14 COMMISSIONERS WHO RESIDE IN THE SERVICE AREA AND ARE CUSTOMERS OF THE 15 PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM. THE COMMISSIONERS, INCLUDING THE INITIAL 16 (2) (I) 17 COMMISSIONERS. SHALL BE ELECTED BY THE INDIVIDUALS WHO RESIDE IN THE 18 SERVICE AREA AND WHO ARE CUSTOMERS OF THE PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM. THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL CONDUCT THE 19 (II)20 ELECTION OF ITS INITIAL COMMISSIONERS. THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL SERVE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 21 22 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE BYLAWS OF THE DISTRICT. 23 THE COMMISSIONERS SHALL SIGN THE ARTICLES OF (1) 24 INCORPORATION AND FILE THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION WITH THE STATE 25 DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION. 26 (2) THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION SHALL: 27 (I) RECEIVE THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION; 28 MARK THE DATE AND TIME OF RECEIPT OF THE ARTICLES OF (II)29 INCORPORATION; AND ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FOR ANY ARTICLES OF 30 (III)31 INCORPORATION THAT COMPLY WITH THIS SUBTITLE. THE NAME OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION AND ALL TRADE 32 (G) (1) 33 NAMES SHALL REMAIN IN THE NAME OF THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT UNTIL

ALL RIGHTS AND PROPERTY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION

36 SHALL BECOME THE RIGHTS AND PROPERTY OF THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT AND

34 CHANGED BY AN ORDER OF THE SANITARY COMMISSION.

- 1 THE DISTRICT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL THE EXISTING OBLIGATIONS OF THE
- 2 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.
- 3 (3) TITLE TO ANY PROPERTY OF THE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SHALL
- 4 BE VESTED IN THE NEWLY FORMED DISTRICT AND NO REVERSION OR IMPAIRMENT
- 5 OF OWNERSHIP RIGHTS SHALL BE CAUSED BY THE CONVERSION TO A DISTRICT.
- 6 (4) THE RIGHT OF ANY CREDITOR MAY NOT BE IMPAIRED BY THIS 7 SECTION WITHOUT THE CREDITOR'S CONSENT.
- 8 (H) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE NEW DISTRICT
- 9 SHALL HAVE ALL THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF A DISTRICT AS PROVIDED UNDER
- 10 THIS SUBTITLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the
- 12 General Assembly that all property, assets, liabilities, duties, processes, permits, and
- 13 proceedings of a nonprofit organization that converts to a sanitary district under this
- 14 Act be continued as the property, assets, liabilities, duties, processes, permits, and
- 15 proceedings of the sanitary district until altered by the sanitary commission.
- 16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 17 July 1, 2004. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June
- 18 30, 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 19 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
