## 2 Wicomico County - Building Excise Tax

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Council of Wicomico County to fix and
- 4 impose, by ordinance, a building excise tax on all types of building construction;
- 5 requiring the County Council to specify in the ordinance the types of building
- 6 construction subject to the tax; authorizing the County Council to impose
- 7 different rates of the building excise tax on different types of building
- 8 construction subject to the tax; requiring that the revenues from the building
- 9 excise tax be deposited in the county's general fund; authorizing the County
- 10 Council to use the revenues from the building excise tax for any lawful purpose;
- and generally relating to authorizing the County Council of Wicomico County to
- impose a building excise tax.

- 22 (A) THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, BY ORDINANCE, MAY FIX
- 23 AND IMPOSE A BUILDING EXCISE TAX ON ANY BUILDING CONSTRUCTION WITHIN
- 24 WICOMICO COUNTY.
- 25 (B) THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL SPECIFY IN THE ORDINANCE THE TYPES OF
- 26 BUILDING CONSTRUCTION SUBJECT TO THE BUILDING EXCISE TAX.

- 1 (C) THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY IMPOSE DIFFERENT RATES OF THE BUILDING
- 2 EXCISE TAX ON DIFFERENT TYPES OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION SUBJECT TO THE
- 3 BUILDING EXCISE TAX.
- 4 (D) (1) THE REVENUES FROM THE BUILDING EXCISE TAX SHALL BE
- 5 DEPOSITED IN THE COUNTY'S GENERAL FUND.
- 6 (2) THE REVENUES FROM THE BUILDING EXCISE TAX MAY BE USED FOR
- 7 ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE WITHIN THE COUNTY.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
