- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, in
- 5 collaboration with other State agencies, to establish and promote a certain
- 6 public awareness campaign relating to the prevention of Fetal Alcohol
- 7 Syndrome; providing for the components of the campaign; authorizing the
- 8 Secretary to use certain resources to carry out the provisions of this Act; and
- 9 generally relating to a public awareness campaign to prevent Fetal Alcohol
- 10 Syndrome.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Health General
- 19 18-309.
- 20 (A) (1) THE SECRETARY, IN COLLABORATION WITH OTHER STATE
- 21 AGENCIES, SHALL ESTABLISH AND PROMOTE A STATEWIDE PUBLIC INFORMATION,
- 22 AWARENESS, AND EDUCATION CAMPAIGN ON FETAL ALCOHOL SYNDROME AND
- 23 OTHER EFFECTS OF PRENATAL ALCOHOL EXPOSURE.
- 24 (2) THE CAMPAIGN SHALL:
- 25 (I) REACH OUT TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND SPECIFIC
- 26 POPULATIONS DETERMINED TO BE AT HIGH RISK FOR CONTRACTING FETAL
- 27 ALCOHOL SYNDROME;

## **HOUSE BILL 1274**

- 1 (II)DISSEMINATE THE INFORMATION ABOUT FETAL ALCOHOL 2 SYNDROME THROUGH WRITTEN MATERIALS, TELEVISION, RADIO, POSTERS, OR ANY 3 OTHER MEDIUM THE SECRETARY CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE AND EFFECTIVE FOR 4 CONVEYING THE INFORMATION; (III) DISTRIBUTE INFORMATIONAL MATERIALS FREE OF CHARGE TO 6 PRENATAL CLINICS AND TO ESTABLISHMENTS THAT SERVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; 7 AND INCLUDE ANY OTHER MATTER THAT THE SECRETARY 8 (IV) 9 CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE. TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY: 10 (B) ON REQUEST, SHALL RECEIVE AID OR INFORMATION FROM ANY 12 AGENCY OF THIS STATE, OR FROM A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION; 13 (2) MAY REQUEST THE SERVICES OF INTERESTED ADVOCACY GROUPS; 14 AND
- 15 MAY CONTRACT FOR ANY NECESSARY SERVICES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2004.
